This Indenture made 30th day of March in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and twenty between Benjamin Plant
 servant of Southampton County of the one part and Benjamin E. Plant
 of said County of the other parts Witnesseth that the said Benjamin
 Plant Sur for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars
 his hundred Dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth to him
 in hand paid by the said Benjamin E. Plant the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by the
 use present do bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin E. Plant
 his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing by
 estimation two hundred and twenty two acres be the same more or
 less lying and being in Southampton County and parish of St. Lukes
 in the State of Virginia within the bounds of the said County and
 parish of St. Lukes and being more particularly described as follows
 to wit Beginning in the South Swamp on the line of Allen Lane
 Estate thence through the various courses of said Swamp to the junction
 of said Swamp with the flat Swamp when they turn to the north
 and afterwards thence up the said flat Swamp to a Gum tree
 along the line between said land and the land belonging to the
 Estate of Daniel Thomas deceased thence along the edge of the
 line of Allen Lane deceased thence along said line to the
 Beginning To have and to hold the said one hundred and twenty
 two acres of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto
 belonging to the said Benjamin E. Plant his heirs and assigns
 forever to be the only proper use and behoof of him the said Benj.
 E. Plant his heirs and assigns forever but the said Benjamin E. Plant
 his heirs and assigns shall have and shall have further covenant and agree
 with the said Benjamin E. Plant his heirs and assigns that the
 said Benjamin E. Plant Sur his heirs Executors and administrators
 shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend the above mentioned
 and lands and premises unto the said Benjamin E. Plant
 his heirs and assigns forever against the claims or demands of all
 and every person or persons whatsoever In witness whereof
 the said Benj. E. Plant Sur hath hereunto set his hand and affix
 ed his seal the day and year first above written signed sealed
