This Indenture made this first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand
and eight hundred and thirty by and between William Parker and Martha
Fowler his wife of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and Richard Murphy
of the same county and state of the other part witnesseth that the said Richard
Murphy and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred
dollars to him in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Richard Murphy
at all before the recording and delivery of this present the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged by the said William Parker and Martha his wife have granted
bargained sold allured and confirmed unto the said Richard Murphy
bargain sell allured and confirmed unto him the said Richard Murphy
affid to his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece or tract of land being
contiguous to the lands of said Richard Murphy containing by estimation thirtynine
thousand and a half acres more or less in the following tract
Beginning at a Pine standing in a Pomegranate tree N 22 W 30
poles to a gum A 53 N 50 E pole to a small gum a corner in millions
Parker's line S 39 W 16 poles to a small tree line S 19 W 17 poles to
a Pine stump a corner in Richard Murphy and William Parker line
line A 64 E 23 1/2 poles 8 links thence due west 20 poles to a gum a corner
of the lands formerly belonging to William Parker line N 80 poles to a
corner oak in Richard Murphy's line thence due east 28 1/2 poles to the
Beginning to have and to hold the said tract of land with all
its appurtenances to him the said Richard Murphy his heirs and assigns forever
to the said William Parker and Martha his wife for their heirs their
executors and administrators do and will warrant and defend the said land
against foremises against the lawfull claim of all and every person what-
ever to him the said Richard Murphy his heirs and assigns forever in witness
whereof he the said William Parker and Martha his wife has hereunto
set her hands and seals this day and date before written Sealed &
