This Indenture made this twenty ninth day of November 1820 in the
 year of our Lord eight hundred and twenty by Richard Murphy and
 Annally his wife of Southampton county Virginia of the one part and William
 Farrow and Matthew Farrow of the same county and State of the other part
 by mail
 Nov. 11th 1820
 Witnesseth that the said Richard Murphy and Annally his wife
 for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to them in hand
 paid at and before this writing said delivery of their persons thereunto
 whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Richard Murphy and Annally
 his wife have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these
 presents a grant bargain sell aliened and confirmed unto them the said
 William Farrow and Matthew Farrow and to their heirs and assigns
 forever a small piece or lot of land being contiguous to the land
 of the said William Farrow and Matthew Farrow containing
 by estimation thirty three and a half acres more or less on the following
 boundaries viz. Beginning at a Young in Edwards Corners
 two three A.G. N. 15 poles to a path three A.G. N. 36 poles down
 a Branch three A. 27 E. 13 poles to a maple a corner in Matthew
 Gardens two three S. 14 E. 11 1/2 poles to a small red oak a
 corner of William Farrow Edwards Corners and Richard Murphy
 living To have and to hold the said thirty three and a half acres of land with
 all its appurtenances to them the said William Farrow and Matthew Farrow
 their heirs and assigns forever And they the said Richard Murphy
 Annally his wife for themselves their heirs executors administrators
 and well warrant and defend the said bargain promising against
 the lawful claim of all and every person whatsoever to them the
 said William Farrow and Matthew Farrow Their heirs and assigns
 forever In witness whereof they the said Richard Murphy and
 Annally his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals this day
 and date before written
