Know all men by these presents that I Henry Smith
are held and firmly bound unto Thomas Branch in the full and
just sum of Twenty five hundred Dollars to be paid unto the
Thomas Branch his heirs Executors administrators or assigns
to which payment well and truly to be made I bind myself
my heirs Executors administrators and assigns jointly severally
and firmly by these presents sealed with my seal and dated this
5th day of December A.D. 1820 -- The condition of the above oblige-
ment is such that whereas the above bound Henry Smith hath de-
eded and put in the possession of the said Thomas Branch his
certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and
fifteen acres lying and being the corner of Southampton and
State of Virginia It being that portion of the Tract of land
known by the name of the Outer tract which was set apart
to the said Henry Smith and his child from the Estate of
Henry Smith deceased Now therefore the above bound
Henry Smith shall well and truly save and keep harmless
the said Thomas Branch his heirs and assigns from all
and every person or persons claiming of said lands and
premises his or her share and perfect Estate in the
said lands and premises unto the said Thomas Branch
his heirs and assigns forever that than this Obligation to be
void otherwise to remain in full force power and virtue
