This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and forty nine between Baldon Jordan Real and Elizabeth his wife of the Parish of Stoneyard and County of Courtland of the one part and Arthur Whitehead of the County of Bedford of the other part witnesseth that the said Jordan Real and his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two Hundred and fifty Dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Arthur Whitehead the receipt whereof they doth hereby acknowledge and themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid their grantee hereinafter called all and singular and by these presents with good bargains and alien release and covenants unto the said Arthur Whitehead the less and appears forever all that land and plantation and Premises with the appurtenances now in the time and occupation of the said Jordan Real situated lying and being in the aforesaid Parish and County containing by Estimation forty acres to the same more or less bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a lightwood post standing at the Road in the line of Millie Sinkers turned a marked tree of said post being to a post standing at the Dam Branch a corner in the line of Dugay Whitehead thence up said Branch to a sapling a corner tree in the line of Dugay Whitehead thence a marked tree is the Road thence down the Road to the beginning being the land the said Jordan Real bought of Jonathan Lister on the south side of the former Bridge Road and all houses and houses occupied buildings yards gardens orchards trees way.
