This Indenture made this fourth day of June in the year Eighteen hundred and twenty one between Thomas Gray of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Thomas P. Gray of the county and state aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Gray for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which he had for his son Thomas P. Gray & well as for the further consideration of One Dollar to him in hand paid by the said Thomas P. Gray at or before the signing and delivery of these presents (the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have given granted allured and confirmed and by these presents do give grant allure and confirm unto the said Thomas P. Gray his heirs Executors administrators and assigns one certain tract and parcel of Lands lying and being situated in the county and state aforesaid and containing by estimation four hundred acres be the same more or less the boundaries of the said lands are designated in a Deed from the Stationary Incorpors to Charles P. Catthorp and is the same tract and parcel of Lands given unto the aforesaid Thomas Gray by the last will and testament of his father the said Thomas Gray and duly recorded in the clerk's office of the aforesaid county of Southampton and the said Thomas Gray for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the said Lands unto the said Thomas P. Gray his heirs Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of John Whitefield Thomas Gray his heirs Executors and administrators and against the claim or claim rightfull or pretensions of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and well forever warrant and defend by these presents In witness whereof have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day and date above written
