This Indenture made this 21st day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one Between Samuel Ketchum of the one part Peter Booth of the second part and Lewis St. Branch of the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said Samuel Ketchum stands partly indebted to the said Peter Booth the sum of ninety three dollars and four cents and by two separate notes one included to Peter Booth individually and the other to Peter Booth and John Booth bearing date the twentieth day of January 1820 as will more fully appear hereinafter being had thereto and the said Samuel Ketchum humbly desiring to secure and pay this Peter Booth as by these presents for himself his heirs and assigns for the consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Peter Booth to Branch bargain and sale to the said Lewis St. Branch trustee his heirs executors administrators or assigns for ever the following articles to wit three feather beds and furniture and some more and six three head cattle six wooden chairs and one table to him and his heirs forever more to be in special trust that the said Lewis St. Branch shall at any time after the first day of June next when required by the said Peter Booth or the said Samuel Ketchum after giving him days previous publish to the said Peter Booth as well as to his heirs and assigns for cash or as much thereof as will satisfy and out of the proceeds pay the said Peter Booth his debt aforesaid and interest also the expense of recording this indenture also all other reasonable expenses attending the sale of the surplus of any after paying the just debts to be paid to the said
