These Indentures made this first day of march one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between Polling St Barnes of the first part Peter Edwards of the second part and Arthur Meredith of the third part all of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesses that whereas the said Peter Edwards has become bound as security for the said Polling St Barnes in a Bond or note given to them as per the Particular for the sum of two hundred dollars with interest as expressed in the said Bond also in sundry bonds payable to the commissioners appointed to sell the Estate of John Barnes amounting in the whole to the sum of three hundred ^{and} dollars and twenty five cents with interest according to the tenor of the said Bonds are also in a Bond given by the said Barnes a administrator of John Barnes deceased in the penalty of ten thousand dollars and the said Polling St Barnes being willing and desirous to secure and save harmless the said Peter Edwards from all damages which he might sustain by reason of his security ships aforesaid This said Polling St Barnes for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid as well for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Arthur Meredith who is mutually chosen is act as Trustee hath granted bargained and sold unto the said Peter Edwards and to his heirs Executors and administrators a certain tract of land containing two hundred and fifty ^{an} acres of land and more or less lying and being in the county aforesaid and is some of the lands whereon the said Polling St Barnes now lives also and more man named Charles Rogers man being many mares and Bredst five head of Horses and white thirty head of cattle Eighty head of Hogs two waggon six gigs and Harshes two cart and wheels horse hold and Hatching furniture and Plantation utensils to and for this special purpose that is to say in case the said Polling St Barnes shall find to pay the aforesaid sums of money so as to discharge the said Peter Edwards having to pay or effect is become dangerous in any way as security for the said Polling St Barnes when and in that case if shall be lawful for the said Arthur Meredith or his representatives at the request of the said Peter Edwards or Polling St Barnes or either of them or either of their Executors or administrators to sell at public sale the several tract of land Horses and other property therein mentioned after giving reasonable public notice of the time and place of sale unto the proceeds of the sale apply to the extinguish amount of the said several debts as well all cost charges incident hereto and the balance pay to the said Polling St Barnes or his legal representatives.
