This Indenture made and entered into this 30th day of June
 in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty four
 between Jacob Pope alias Jacob Rich of the first part bearing
 Bonds of the second part and Henry Briggs of the third part
 all of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia
 Witnesseth that the said Jacob Pope alias Jacob Rich for and
 in consideration of the sum of forty four dollars and ninety two cents
 which said sum is due from the said Jacob Pope alias Jacob Rich
 to the said Edwards Bettle by bonds bearing date the 30th day of
 June one thousand eight hundred and twenty one as well as all
 other monies which may be due and owing from the said Jacob
 Pope alias Jacob Rich to the said Edwards Bettle by means
 of any dealings transfers of title or papers whatever or also for and
 in consideration of one dollar to have in hand paid by the said
 Henry Briggs the receipt whereof the said Jacob Pope alias
 Jacob Rich doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and
 sell convey and make over unto the said Henry Briggs
 and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the
 following property to wit one certain tract or parcel of
 land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded by
 the lands of Richard Rich James Whitehead and Mark
 Macdonald containing fifty acres two hundred and thirty
 and two heads of cattle and very part of the crop of corn &
 potatoes now growing upon the plantation here in
 acceptance of said Edwards Bettle belonging to him the
 said Jacob Pope. To Have and to hold all this right and
 interest of the said Jacob Pope hereunto conveyed or intended to be
 to let conveyed to him the said Henry Briggs his heirs and
 assigns forever upon the special bond notwithstanding that the said
 Henry Briggs upon being there required by the aforesaid
