Johnson to Simmons

This Indenture made this twenty first day of March Eighteen hundred and twenty one Between Joshua Johnson and Lucy his wife of the one part and Polly Simmons of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that the said Joshua Johnson and Lucy his wife do for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars and fifty Cents to them in hand paid by the said Polly Simmons at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold alliened and confirmed unto her the said Polly Simmons her and her heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County and State and bounded as follows Beginning at a small Post oak by the side of Danvers Road in Etheldred Edmunds line running about north along the said Edmunds line to a small Gasparas post the said line a new corner made thence about East to a shot a new or in Joshua Johnson line thence about South along the said Johnsons line to the said road thence along the road to the Beginning containing five acres be the same more or less To Have and to Hold the said five acres of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Polly Simmons her and her heirs forever of the only proper assigns forever and the said Joshua Johnson and Lucy his wife their heirs their assigns and administrators and assigns shall
