

Richardson His Indenture made and entered into this 27th day
 Moore's Trust of July in the year of our Lords one thousand eight hundred and
 Examined and returned in Person John C. Richardson of the County of Southampton
 delivred to and to the State of Virginia of the first part John Moore of the
 J. Pittman same County and to the State of the second part and
 Jan'y 21 1888 Thomas Pittman of the same County and to the State of the third
 part witnesseth that the said John C. Richardson for
 and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in
 hands paid by the said John Moore at or before the
 making hereof delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged as well as for the full
 then sum consideration of the said John C. Richardson
 being justly and due to the said Thomas Pittman
 in the full and full sum of four hundred dollars and
 full money of the United States due by Bonds which
 he the said John C. Richardson is willing more effec-
 ually to secure to the said Thomas Pittman and which
 is the fact the sole object of these presents hath granted
 bargained sold conveyed and confirmed and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the
 said John Moore and his heirs and assigns forever the
 said parcel of Lands that I now live on being the land
 that I purchased of Benjamin Hunt becomer of the late
 late Henry New purchase containing by a late survey eight
 hundred and twenty five acres by the square more or less lying
 an Holloway River in the County of Southampton and bounded
 by its Runoff and reported by the said John Moore and
 parcel of land unto him the said John Moore his heirs
 assigns forever but upon this special trust and condition that
 the said John Moore his heirs Executors or assigns upon being
 thereto required by the said Thomas Pittman his heirs Executors
 or assigns to make sale of the land at Publick
 Auction for the best price that can be obtained for the
 same after advertising the time and place of sale of the said
 lands ten days at least at the most Publick place near
 the said Land or at the Court House door of the said County
 of Southampton and with the money arising from the said
 first Pay to the said Thomas Pittman and of four hundred
 of four hundred dollars with lawful interest from date
 of payment till paid and the cost attending the sale
 and then pay the surplus that shall remain to the
