This Indenture made this 7th day of July in the year 1821
between James Hardiman of the first part, Planter Rochester
of the second part and James Rochester of the third part
all of the county of Southampton in the State of Virginia -
Witnesseth whereas the said James Hardiman is greatly
indebted to the said James Rochester in the sum of
one hundred dollars and eighty five cents to be paid on the
24th day of January 1821 and by state bearing date the
22nd day of January 1821 which with the said James Hardi-
man is willing and desirous to secure, after this indenture
Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises is and also
for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful money
of Virginia to the said James Hardiman in hand paid by
the said James Rochester at an before the sealing and delivery
of this present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
by the said James Hardiman hath given granted bargained
sold allured enfeoffed rewards aforesaid confirmed and by this
present as to his grant bargain sell alien enfeoffed released
and confirmed to the said James Rochester his heirs and assigns
forever the following property to wit one white cow for
Hogs three feather Birds and furniture two chest a parcel
of chino and crockery and also a parcel of glass ware and
looking glass one hund a half dozen Spoons one tea tray
two saucers three butter totes two spinning wheels one coffee
mill and coffee pot one wash tubs 1 pairing frame wortspins
and two sets over the trap candle sticks one breadkettle
one floor carpet there and around one acre land and hummock
one Spade two table cloths one safe two water pails one basket
bread bags two bar ^{brown} candles one set knives and forks one
Knife Rose one saddle and Bridle a parcel of Books and the
balance of my property of every kind whatsoever to have and
to hold the aforesaid property unto him the said James Rochester
his heirs and assigns forever upon his special trust and confirmed
that the said James Rochester his heirs etc. &c. dont shal at any
time at the request of the said James Rochester his heirs etc. or
a court or master sell at Publick auction the aforesaid property
for cash or so much thereof as well be sufficient to pay his
debts for the aforesaid debt and all cost and interest account
thereon and also all other monies which may be due or
owing to the said James Rochester by any party or persons
