year Eighteen hundred and twenty Thomas Sorden and Henry his wife
of Gloucester County and State of Virginia of the one part and Arthur
Williamson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the
other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Sorden and Henry his
wife for and consideration of the sum of one thousand and forty
three dollars and twenty five cents of lawful money of this commonwealth
to him in hand paid by the said Arthur Williamson at or before the making
and delivery of this presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell
unto the said Arthur Williamson his heirs and assigns a certain tract or
parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and
Bounded as follows To wit on the East by the lands of the said Arthur
Williamson and John Levy on the west by the lands of Thomas Will-
iamson on the South by the lands of John Levy and on the North
by the three creeks as reference being had to the former and well
known fully appear the boundaries and the corner is and distance containing
three hundred and twenty one acres by late survey to the Commons
or less To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcels of land
together with all the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any
wise appertaining and all its privileges to and for the only proper
use and behoof of him the said Arthur Williamson his heirs and
assigns forever and the said Thomas Sorden and Henry his wife
for themselves and their heirs doth hereby convey said lands with
all and singular the premises and appurtenances before
mentioned unto the said Arthur Williamson his heirs and
assigns free from the claims or claims of the said
Thomas
