This Indenture made the twelfth day of October in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty between Henry Harris and Elizabeth E. Harris his wife of Southampton County of the one part and Alexander P. Pete of the same County of the other part witnesseth That the said Henry Harris and Elizabeth E. Harris his wife in consideration of the sum of thirteen hundred dollars current money of this commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Alexander P. Pete before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them certain Tracts or parcels of land containing seventy five acres be the same more or less and Bounded as follows Commencing for the year near the South passing door of the House formerly owned by Thomas Pete of Dr. Thomas there along Alexander Pete line to the three eights thence up the three eights to a corner of the Thomas E. Pete line to the Commencement near the said door Together with all and singular the appurtenances thereof and their heirs and assigns forever and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said land with the tenements appurtenances and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Alexander Pete his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and Benefit of him the said Alexander Pete his heirs forever and the said Henry Harris and Elizabeth E. Harris his wife for themselves and their heirs the said land with all and singular the premises the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Alexander Pete his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Henry Harris and Elizabeth E. Harris his wife or in their of them their or either of their heirs and of all and persons or persons whatsoever shall with and without warrant and force defend by these presents in witness whereof the said Henry Harris and Elizabeth E. Harris his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
