Pete for or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt or hereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them certain Tracts or parcel of land containing seventy five acres be the same more or less and Bounded as follows Commencing for the year near the south facing door of the House formerly owned by Thomas Pete of Dr. Thomas Thoma along Alexander Pete line to the three corners thence up the three corners to a corner of the of Thomas E. Pete's line to the Commencement near the said door together with all and singular the appurtenances thereof and their heirs and assigns forever and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said land with all tenements appurtenances and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights incidents and appurtenances unto the said Alexander Pete his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and Benefit of him the said Alexander Pete his heirs forever and the said Harry Harris and Elizabeth E. Harris his wife for themselves and their heirs the said land with all and singular other the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Alexander Pete his heirs and assigns forever from the claim or claims of them the said Harry Harris and Elizabeth E. Harris his wife or either of them their mother of their heirs and of all and persons or persons whatsoever shall with and at instance and petition depend by these presents in anywise whereof the said Harry Harris and Elizabeth E.
