This Indenture made this 19th day of May in the
year of our Lord 1821. Between Miles Scarborough and wife Delila of the
county of Southampton of the one part and James Stiles of the said
County of the other party to witness that the said Miles Scarborough
ought and Delila for and in consideration of the sum of three
hundred and fifty five dollars unto them in hand paid by the
said James Stiles at or before the concluding and delivering
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
full grants & bargains sold alway resbands and confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release &
convey unto the said James Stiles one certain tract of land
and parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid
containing by estimation 135 1/2 acres like the same described
and bounded as by the lands of William Briggs Esq late brother to
James Stiles and George Blew with the reversion or the
reversion to remaine in the remainder and every part and
parcel thereof to have and to hold to the said James Stiles
her heirs or assigns forever and the said Miles Scarborough &
wife Delila for themselves their heirs &c the said bargained
sums freely Conveyed and intended to be conveyed doth seal
and will affix unto the said James Stiles her heirs or assigns
against the claims or claims of all and every person or persons
whatsoever testifying whereof the said Miles Scarborough
and Delila his wife full hands set their hands and seals
