This Indenture made this 19th day of May in the
year of our Lord 1831. Between Miles Scarborough and wife, Debra of the

county of the other part. It is testified that the said Miles Scarborough
right and Debra for and in consideration of the sum of three
hundred and fifty five dollars unto them in hand paid by the
said Anna Hines at or before the making and delivering
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have granted bargained sold alien released and confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release &
confirm unto the said Anna Hines one certain tract-plant
and parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid
containing by estimation 150 ft. and like the same tract or lot
and bounded by the land of William Briggs Elsie lotter Comp
James Hines and George Blom with the reversion or the
reversions the remainder or the remainders and every part and
parcel thereof to have and to hold to the said Anna Hines
her heirs or assigns forever unto the said Miles Scarborough &
wife Debra for themselves their heirs &c. the said bargained
premises hereby conveyed and intended to be conveyed doeth she
and will repairance unto the said Anna Hines her heirs or assigns
against the claims or claims of all and every person or persons
whatsoever to the testimony whereof the said Miles Scarborough
and Debra his wife hath hereunto set their hands and seals
