Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Washington of the County of Southampton in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear unto my beloved Sister Elizabeth Washington and also for divers other good causes and consideration unto the said Benjamin Washington hereto money have given grants and confirmed and by these presents do give grant and confirm unto the said Elizabeth Washington all my right and title to one Negro woman named Lucy who was born of a Negro woman named Kate which Negro woman was purchased by the said Benjamin Washington by my father James Washington gifted to me in like manner or found to with the same intention I do hereby give grant and confirm to the said Elizabeth Washington my right and title to the said Lucy child named Jack to Harb and to Hild and enjoy both the woman and child unto the said Elizabeth Washington her heirs executors administrators and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Elizabeth Washington her heirs executors administrators and assigns forever And I the said Benjamin Washington for myself my heirs executors and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend and save unto the said Elizabeth Washington her heirs the said Lucy and child from all and every person or persons claiming them in any right or title I have hereunto set my hand and seal this tenth day of September 1821
