This Indenture made the twentieth day of May in the year 1821 between Edwin Barnes of the County of Southampton of the first part Alexander Myrick of the County aforesaid of the second part and William H Barnes of the same County of the third part Testifyeth that the said William H Barnes has a note dated the twentieth of May executed to him by said Edwin Barnes for the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars and whereas the said Edwin Barnes is willing and desirous to secure and save harmless the said William H Barnes from any loss or injury he might sustain and for the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Edwin Barnes hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell enfeoff and confirm unto the said Alexander Myrick his Executors assigns the following personal estate to wit 1 two feather beds and furniture all the House hold and Kitchen furniture ten head of cattle fourteen head of sheep and twenty one head of Hogs together with all & singular the appurtenances belonging or any ways appertaining to the aforesaid her furniture &c &c to the said Alexander Myrick
