This Indenture made this 29th day of May 1823 between James Greenwell of
the County of Southampton of the first part Frederick Collett of the same County of
the second part and Jacob Darden of the third part Witnesseth that
whereas the said James Greenwell stands justly indebted unto the said
Frederick Collett in the sum of fifty two dollars and thirty six cents
by State or specially bearing date the 10th day of January 1820 and
being willing and desirous to secure the payment thereof unto the
said Frederick Collett for and satisfaction of the promise aforesaid
but more especially for and satisfaction of the sum of one dollar
to him the said James Greenwell in hand paid by the said Jacob
Darden the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
bargained sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and
sell unto the said Jacob Darden his heirs Executors and administrators
one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation fifty two
acres being the same land whereon the said James Greenwell now
lives and bounded by the lands of said Frederick Collett The heirs of
John Lerney and the Estate of Henry Vaughan and the Estate of Jesse
Gardner and to have and to hold the before mentioned tract and
parcel of land unto the said Jacob Darden his heirs Executors and
