Barham both of thirty five acres thence corner at 79 or 189 poles to a new corner of the Morris corner and James A. Barham both of thirty five acres thence S. 15 W. 33 poles to a small red oak bush near the lower corner of Jas. Hobbs thence S. 25 E. 40 poles to the first Station
