This Indenture made this 21st day of July in the year of our Lord
thousand eight hundred and twenty and between Cordale Drantley
of Southampton County and parcels of St. Leger of the one part and Edmund
Turner of the same County and parcels of the other part (Witnesseth) that the
said Cordale Drantley for and in consideration of the sum of nineteen
hundred and eighty five dollars current money of Virginia to him now
paid by the said Edmund Turner the receipt whereof the said Cordale
Drantley doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and paid
hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these
presentes hath granted bargained and sold unto the said Edmund
Turner his heirs and assigns forever an certain tract or parcel of land
and premises which the said Edmund Turner purchased of the
said Cordale Drantley containing by a late survey made by the
County Surveyor thirty hundred and twenty seven acres going to the
milespace up to Coker Swamp and thence as follows to wit
Beginning at the intersection of the milepost and the bridge
branch thence up the various courses of the milepost to Coker
Swamp to the intersection of the Coker branch and the said Coker
Swamp thence along the meanderings of the said Coker branch
to a small black gum standing at or near the head of the
Coker branch a corner of Captain Mearns thence S 65 E 12 poles to
a large dead white oak thence S 75 E 60 poles to a black gum
a corner of Captain Spear standing at the head of the bridge
branch thence along the various courses of the bridge branch to
the first station where various courses meet more fully appear
by having reference to the present survey of the late Surveyor made
on the 24th of July 1824 annexed to this deed containing three hundred
and ninety seven acres in the said more or less and bounded as the
platth directs viz thus with all houses out houses Cider buildings
yards Gardens & churps ways water and water courses whatsoever belonging
or in anywise appertaining to have have and to hold the same unto the said
Edmund Turner his heirs and to his heirs forever and the said Cordale
Drantley for himself his heirs Executors assigns doth by these presentes
covenant and grant to and with the said Edmund Turner his heirs &
assigns that he will by these presentes warrant and forever defend all
right and title claims and demands of any person or persons claiming
or demanding the same or any part or part or share thereof
