This Indenture made this 29 day of December in the year 1820 Between Lewis Waller Peter Edwards and David Westbrook Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton to make sale of the lands of Charlotte Turner deceased lying in the County aforesaid of the one part and Archibald Harris of that said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Lewis Waller Peter Edwards and David Westbrook Commissioners aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and twelve dollars 25 cents to them in hand paid by the said Archibald Harris the receipt whereof now the said Lewis Waller Peter Edwards and David Westbrook both hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold allured and confirmed unto the said Archibald Harris and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid and on the South side of the three creeks & being a certain tract or parcel of land purchased by the said Charlotte Turner of Thomas J. Mayberry and wife heretofore as follows to wit Beginning at a white oak in Archibald Harris' line thence West 22 East 120 poles to a maple in James Branch thence down the various courses of the said branch to a black gum in Thomas Ridley's line thence along his line to a pine thence along a line of marked trees to the beginning containing 70 1/2 acres in the same more or less to have and to hold the said County and three fourths of said land with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Archibald Harris his heirs and assigns forever and for the said Lewis Waller Peter Edwards and David Westbrook Commissioners doth further covenant and agree with the said Archibald Harris his heirs and assigns that now the said Lewis Waller Peter Edwards and David Westbrook under the authority of the said Deed of our said Court shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend the said numerous Land and premises unto the said Archibald Harris his heirs and assigns forever against the claim

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
