This Indenture made this first day of October in the year of our Lord 1821 between John Thomas of the first part and Stuart Edwards of the second part and Thomas H Edwards of the third part Whereas the said Stuart Edwards in order to secure the payment of the sum of four hundred and thirty three dollars and forty nine cents due 18th January 1820 to the said Thomas H Edwards on the 18th day of January in the year 1820 did by Indenture of Trust of that date coming to the said John Thomas his heirs to the following property to wit: all his land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and also one negro man Lewis upon trust for use and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned and whereas since the executing and drawing of the said deed in trust the said Stuart Edwards hath fully paid and paid the said Thomas H Edwards the sum of money thereby secured which the said Thomas H Edwards
