 against the said negro girl Fanny unto the said Jane Applegate
 her heirs Executors administrators and assigns and against the
 claim of her the said Ann Harris her Executors and assigns and
 against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons
 whosoever shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend them by
 these presents in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
 affixed my seal this fourth day of August eighteen hundred &
 twenty one
