This Indenture made this 3rd day of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between Benjamin Whitfield of the first part Edward Deal of the second part and Edmund Pick of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas Benjamin Whitfield stands jointly indebted to the said Edward Deal in the sum of One hundred and eighty four dollars 14 Cents by note bearing date the day and date above written on demand with interest thereon from the date thereof and the said Benjamin Whitfield being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the aforesaid sum of money with interest accruing thereon to the said Edward Deal as well for and insatisfaction of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Edmund Pick the receipt whereof the said Benjamin Whitfield doth hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Edward Deal his heirs and assigns forever one piece parcel tract of Land lying in the County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke's containing one hundred acres more or less situate being the same Land devised by Benjamin Whitfield deceased to the said Benjamin Whitfield by his last will and Testament which is of record in the County Court of Southampton which said Land is called and known by the name of Buck Lane
