This Indenture made this 22nd day of February in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one
 between Henry M. Pittman of the one part and John Vaper
 of the other part all of the County of Southampton places of Potomac
 and state of Virginia witnesses that whereas the said Henry M.
 Pittman is entitled to a certain tract of Land containing one
 hundred and fifty acres be it the same more or less the boundaries
 as follows Beginning at a white oak cornering on Miller's Mill's Land
 running up a meadow by a line of marked trees nearly an east to
 a black gum thence nearly due north by a line of marked trees on
 the adjacent tract to a red oak thence down and east to Garah's Branch
 thence down the said Garah's Branch to the main run of the mill
 swamp thence up the said mill swamp running to the bend
 to a large black dogwood thence due south to a small black dogwood
 thence due west to the mill stream to a small gum thence
 bounded by the mill pond and its overflow to the beginning
 Devised and bequeathed to the said Henry Pittman by the last
 will and Testament of his father Phillips Pittman and
 the said Henry M. Pittman for and in consideration of the
 sum of Seven hundred and fifty one dollars current money of
 Virginia by the said John Vaper to the said Henry M. Pittman
 do hereby acknowledge and forever acquit and discharge the said
 John Vaper his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever the said
 Henry M. Pittman has granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these
 presents doth grant bargain and conveyance and transfer unto the said
 John Vaper his heirs and assigns forever all the said Land which
 the said Henry M. Pittman has in right of the said Phillips Pittman
 does well and which has or may in any manner and way be
 entitled to together with all and every advantage emolument and
 interest in any wise appurtenant to it to have and to hold
