This instrument made this 22nd day of February in the
Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one
of which Henry M Pittman of the one part and John Vaper
of the other part all of the County of Southampton Town of Astoria
and State of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said Henry M.
Pittman is entitled to a certain tract of Land containing one
hundred and fifty acres he is the same moreover by the boundaries
as follows Beginning at a white oak tree cornering on Miles Stevens Land
running up a meadow by a line of marked trees nearly an east to
a black gum three nearly due north by a line of marked trees on
the adams tract to a red oak three nearly due east to Gandy Branch
thence down the said Gandy Branch to the main run of the mill
ditch thence up the said Mill Ditch running ^{not} to the west
to a large black dinner three due south to a white birch
gum three due east to the said tree to a small gum three
bordered by the mill pond and its overflowing to the beginning
Devised land bequeathed to the said Henry Pittman by the last
Will and Testament of his Father Phillips Pittman deceased
the said Henry M Pittman for and in consideration of the
sum of Seven hundred and fifty one dollars current money of
Virginia by the said John Vaper to the said Henry M Pittman
deed hereby acknowledge and forever accept and discharge the said
John Vaper his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever ^{to his}
Henry M Pittman his grantees hisgaines sole and exclusive and of his
private stock grant him and any succession and transfer unto the said
John Vaper his heirs and assigns forever to the said Land which
the said Henry M Pittman has in right of the said Phillips Pittman
deed mill one of which he is or may in any manner and may be
entitled to together with all and every advantage amendment and
interest in any wise appertaining to to have and to hold
