This Indenture made this 2nd day of February one thousand eight hundred
and twenty one Between William J. Smith of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia of the one part and Cordale Brantley of the
same County of the other part witnesseth that whereas the said
Cordale Brantley did on the 25th July 1820 Execute a deed of
Trust to the said William J. Smith for the benefit and on trust for
David Westbrook conveying a certain tract of land lying and being in the aforesaid
County of Southampton containing three hundred and forty four acres which deed
intrust hath been duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton and whereas
the above named Cordale Brantley has paid and discharged the said William
J. Smith the amount due in the said deed of Trust the receipts whereof he
doth hereby acknowledge Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said
William J. Smith for and in consideration of the promise and also of
one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Cordale Brantley doth hereby
release bargain sell and convey with his right title and Interest to and
in the premises by virtue of the said deed of trust unto the said
Cordale Brantley to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of
Land unto the said Cordale Brantley and to his heirs and assigns forever
