This Indenture made this 20th day of July in the year of our Lords
Christ one thousand eight hundred and Twenty one by and between
James Jones and Caty his wife both of the County of Southampton
of Virginia and Parish of Fitzroy of the one part and Louisa Jones
daughter of the said James Jones and Caty his wife of the same
County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said
James Jones and Caty his wife after a reservation of the life
right of the said James Jones and Caty his wife for and
in consideration of the natural love and affection which they bear
Towards the said Louisa Jones their daughter as well as for the
further consideration of the sum of one Dollar to them in hand
paid by the said Louisa Jones at or before the sealing and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have granted given and by these presents doth give and Grant unto
the said Louisa Jones to her and to her heirs forever one certain
Tract or parcel of Land and premises including the lands wherein
the said James Jones and Caty his wife now live also the Lands
whereon Henry Jones formerly lived and all the lands lying
on the east side of the Catfish Swamp which lands are now in one
compact Body which lands well more fully appear by Books
recorded in the County Court of Southampton from Henry Jones
his life time and also a tract of land as a Gift and bargain and sale
one from John Drake and wife all of which Tracts contains
four hundred and twenty five acres be the same more or less
and Bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a red oak
corner of Lemuel Stinton at the head of a Potomac Branch
near the road thence up the said Road to the various courses
thence to a post a corner of William Snyder Standings
on the side of the road across and thence along William
Snyder line to the Catfish Swamp thence up the said Swamp
the various courses thereof to a small Black Gum a corner
made in Joshua Whitney's line at Charles Dean
thence N 78 E 160 Pole between Whitney and James Jones
to the Pecorum thence along the edge of the Pecorum a line
of marked Trees to a Maple a corner of Whitney's line
along Whitney's line through the Pecorum to Cole's corner
including the Pecorum thence along the east side
of the parcel along Ballou's line to the lower Branch

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
