This Indenture made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord  
1820, one Thomas Eight hundred and thirty one between William D  
Powell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part  
and David Westbrook of the same County and State of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said William D Powell in order to secure the  
payment of the following debts (viz) one Bond executed to the  
Westbrook for the sum of three hundred Dollars on demand the 30<sup>th</sup>  
day of August and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in  
hand paid by the said David Westbrook at or before the making  
and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
by the said William D Powell hath granted bargained and sold and  
by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said David  
Westbrook one certain negro boy named Jacob to have and to hold  
unto the said David Westbrook the aforesaid negro to the only proper  
use and behalf of him the said Westbrook his heirs and assigns  
forever in special trust and Confidence to the intent and purpose  
that if the aforesaid sum of three hundred and more dollars shall  
remain unpaid to the said Jacob Westbrook his heirs Executors or  
assigns at or upon the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December eight hundred and  
twenty one that then the said David Westbrook his heirs or assigns  
shall after giving reasonable notice Expose the aforesaid negro to  
public sale and with the money arising therefrom first to pay  
and satisfy the above mentioned sum with interest and cost and  
also the expenses attending of the Execution of the trust and the  
surplus (if any) return to me the said Powell my heirs or assigns  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day  
and year first above written signed sealed and delivered in
