ministrators the said Male Negro slave to the said Robert Recks his Executors and ad-
ministrators and assigns against all and every other person and persons whatsoever shall and
between the parties to these presents Provide always that it is hereby declared
admitted or assigns or any of us do and shall well and truly pay or cause
to be paid unto the said Robert Recks or his certain attorney Executors administrators
or assigns the just and full sum of four hundred dollars on or before the
15th day of October in the year of our Lord 1821 for the redemption of the
heretofore bargained slave then these presents and every clause article condition
and thing herein contained shall cease and be void otherwise to remain in
full force and virtue In Witness whereof we have hereunto affixed
our hands and seals this 11th day of October 1821
