

This Indenture made This day of October 1821 between David
 Newson of the County of Southampton of the first part John Thomas of
 the said County of the second part and John M. Gentry of the same County
 of the third part all of the state of Virginia Witnesseth that whereas
 the said David Newson stands justly indebted to the said John Thomas
 in the just and full sum of One Hundred Seventy five dollars and
 thirty nine and a half Cts Current money of the United States as
 well more fully appears by a Note Executed by the said David
 Newson bearing date the 22nd day of October 1821 to the said
 John Thomas and the said David Newson being willing and desirous
 to secure the payment of the aforesaid sum of money to the said John
 Thomas his heirs and assigns This Indenture therefore Witnesseth
 that the said David Newson as well and in consideration of the premises
 aforesaid as for and in consideration of an Dollar to him and
 have paid by the said John M. Gentry the receipt Whereof
 the said David Newson doth hereby acknowledge he the said
 David Newson hath granted bargained and sold and do by
 these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said John M.
 Gentry his heirs Executors administrators or assigns the following prop-
 erty Wipe one black mare three head and furniture two painted chest
 three chair frames one pine cupboard one pine safe one walnut table
 one pine table one gun thirty three shot five head cattle Ten head
 sheep one stile thirty three Cider Presses one Loom and Laver
 four Fats frying pan dutch oven one Hoghead fifty barrels
 of Corn four Stands of black Ladder three stacks of Wops fodder
 one cart and wheels Bredle and Man Saddle one old negro woman
 a parcel of Rustin the whole in my possession all of my plates dishes
 and all species of personalty in my possession To Have and to hold
 unto the said John M. Gentry his heirs Executors and administrators
 or assigns the aforesaid property all and every part thereof or upon
 the condition that the said John M. Gentry may at any time
 at the request of the said John Thomas take possession of any part
 and every part of the said property the said David Newson and assigns
 shall and may be Lawful for the said John M. Gentry his heirs
 or administrators at any time at the request of the said John
 Thomas to make sale of the aforesaid property or so much thereof
 as may be sufficient to pay and satisfy and pay unto the said
