This chandlure made this twentieth day of October one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between Thomas James of the one part Edwards Butts of the second part and John Denigre of the third part all of the County of Fauquier and state of Virginia Notwithst that the said Thomas James being willing and desirous to secure the said John Denigre as security to Richard Riches for a certain sum bearing date the 20th day of February 1820 for the sum of six hundred dollars with interest thereon to be paid and for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Edwards Butts the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Thomas James to the said Thomas James last bengard and sold unto the said Edwards Butts his heirs Exec^t adm^r or assignee for ever the following property fifty fat Hog one spike iron Head cattle skin two of sheep one mappon and silver watch two shot Quins one thousand pounds of sand Cotton one walnut case one small ovalnut Table one trap ladder one walnut drum of Table room Sams one Peac one large Bull one Green Potts all my Books two horse carts wheels one looking glass one Pasteles two thirty Bushels pease four sides leather half dozen Mendon chains amount of 14 bushels value and Hutchingsons debts and all the rest of my property not therefore mentioned to the said Edwards Butts his heirs Exec^t adm^r and assignee for ever to witness that in the said Edwards Butts when required by either of the above parties after ground ten days notice at the Court House door of Fauquier County the time and place of sale shall proceed to sell for and charge his party and first pay and satisfy all cost and charges attending such sale and then the debt of record with interest that may grow due thereon and the surplus of any to be paid over to the said Thomas James his heirs Exec^t adm^r or any other person who he may be authorized under his hand to receive the same No witness whereof I have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of
