This Indenture made this Twentieth day of October one Thousand eight hundred and twenty one between Thomas Lewis of the one part Edwards Butts of the second part and John Dungeon of the third part all of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Thomas Lewis being willing and desirous to secure the said John Dungeon as Security to Richard Riches for a certain Bond bearing date the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February 1820 for the sum of Six hundred dollars with interest Wharson told pair and for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Edwards Butts the inclosed whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Thomas Lewis to the said Thomas Lewis both bargain and sold unto the said Edwards Butts he has been admitted or assigns forever the following property fifty fat hogs one spoke over ten head cattle eleven head of sheep one maffoon one silver watch two shot Guns one thousand pounds of seed cotton one walnut case one small walnut Table one trap powder gun walnut drum of Table iron saws one Bow one large Bull iron screw Potts all my Potts two horse carts two wheels one Looking glass ten Bushels Rice thirty Bushels peas four six leather half dozen iron chains amount of four eight cuts and Hushingtons duties and all the rest of my property not theretofore mentioned to the said Edwards Butts this has been admitted and assigns forever upon Trust nevertheless that in the said Edwards Butts shall be required by either of the above parties after giving ten days notice at the Court House door of Southampton County the time and place of sale shall proceed to sell for cash the forgoing property and first pay and satisfy all cost and charge attending such sale and then the debt of bond with interest shall may grow due thereon and the surplus of any to be paid over to the said Thomas Lewis he has been admitted or assigns or any other person unto he may be authorized under his hand to Receive the same in witness whereof one have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year above written Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of
