 To Isaac and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be granted slaves and
 other personal property hereby conveyed unto the said William Ricks and Robert
 Ricks Trustees their Executors administrators and assigns forever and the said
 Thomas Jones for himself his heirs Executors and administrators doth hereby covenant
 promise and agree to and with the said William Ricks and Robert Ricks Trustees
 their Executors do. forever in manner and forms following that is to say
 that the said Thomas Jones his heirs Executors do. the aforesaid slaves and all
 other personal property hereby conveyed unto the said William Ricks and
 Robert Ricks Trustees their Executors do. against all persons whatsoever
 shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents upon
 Trust nevertheless that the said William and Robert Ricks Trustees
 their Executors administrators do. shall permit the said Thomas Jones to
 remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said slaves and other aforesaid
 personal property hereby conveyed and take the profits thereof to his own use until
 default be made in the payment of the said sum of fourteen hundred and
 twenty five dollars and ninety cents either in the whole or in part And then
 upon this further Trust that the said William Ricks and Robert Ricks
 or either of them or either of their Executors do. shall or will so soon after
 the happening of such default of payment or either of them their heirs Executors
 administrators or assigns of such default may think proper or the said
 Robert Ricks or his Executors administrators or assigns shall request sell
 the aforesaid slaves and all the other personal property hereby conveyed or
 such part thereof as the Trustees or their representatives hereby authorized to
 do shall think sufficient for the purpose and shall think proper to sell
 to the highest bidder for ready money at publick Auction after
 having first the time and place of sale at their own discretion and
 given ten days notice by advertisement to be set up at the Court House
 of Hampshire County and out of the monies arising from such sale shall
 after satisfying the charges thereof and all other expenses attending said
 sale pay to the said Robert Ricks senior his Executors administrators and
 assigns the said sum of fourteen hundred and twenty five dollars and 90c
 with the interest which may thereof lawfully have accrued and the balance
 if any shall be paid to the said Thomas Jones his heirs Executors administra-
 tors or assigns But if the whole of the said sum of fourteen hundred and
 twenty five dollars and ninety cents with interest thereon shall lawfully
 be paid off and discharged to the said Robert Ricks or his heirs
 or assigns on or before the day of November in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and twenty one when the sum is payable
