This Indenture made this the fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one Between John Hargrave and Catharine his wife of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia and in the Town District of South Lakes Parish of 11th one part and Cum Vick of the same State County and parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Hargrave and Catharine his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Cum Vick or or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents have the said Cum Vick his heirs and assigns their and all of their heirs right and assigns belonging in the lands of Samuel Vick decd. which in the said Samuel Vick did seize and sec. To wit of a fee simple full other of him the said Samuel Vick decd. to have and to hold the within bargained premises right title interest and Estate herein contained unto him the said Cum Vick his heirs and assigns forever with the privilege of hunting fowling fowling bird fishing and all other the profits thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the said John Hargrave and Catharine his wife by these presents doth agree to and with the said Cum Vick in manner to wit that is to say that they the said John Hargrave and Catharine his wife has a good and Lawfull right to sell and convey the within bargained premises unto him the said Cum Vick his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Hargrave and Catharine his wife by these presents doth for them selves their heirs and assigns and well warrant and forever defend a good and Lawfull right unto him the said Cum Vick his heirs and assigns forever against the claim and claims of all and every persons or persons whatsover and by whomsoever made In witness testimony whereof we the said John Hargrave and Catharine his wife hath hereunto set their hands to their seals affixed in presence of
