THIS INDENTURE made and entered into this 21 day of September in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between Goodman
 John Branch of the first part Samuel P Summerville of the second part and John
 Urquhart of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of
 Virginia witnesseth that the said Goodman Branch for and in consideration
 of the sum of Eleven hundred and forty four dollars forty two
 cents which said sum is due from the said Goodman Branch to the
 said John Urquhart by bond bearing date the 21 day of September one
 thousand eight hundred and twenty as well as all other monies which
 may be due and owing from the said Goodman Branch to the said
 John Urquhart by means of any dealing transfers of debts or paper
 whatsoever as also for and in consideration of one dollar to him in
 hand paid by the said Samuel P Summerville the receipt whereof the
 said Goodman Branch doth hereby acknowledge hath granted barg-
 ained and sold and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain
 and sell convey and make over unto the said Samuel P Summerville
 and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the following
