in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to them in hand paid
by the said Polly Wick the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted
Margaret Solo petitioners ex officio and confirmed heirs her the said Polly Wick
her heirs and assigns forever all their interest title claim or demand of in &
to one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid
County of Southampton and State of Virginia being a part of the land
and plantation of said Wick then further did said Wick and her heirs of conveying
by a deed bearing thirty nine and a half acres in the same manner and
purpose as before said beginning at a black gum standing in the name of the
said Wick a new corner of Lewis Wick in Drury Boyant line thence along the
said Lewis Wick line to the N 86° E to a lighted post a new corner of Lewis
Wick in John Wick line thence along the said John Wick line S 74° E to a lighted post a new corner of John Terry and John Wick thence along
said Terry line to a new corner of John Terry and John Wick line S 74° E to another lighted post
a new corner of John Terry and Lewis Wick thence along S 74° E to a lighted post in John Wick and Lewis
