You know all men by these presents that I Richard Northampton of the County of Stafford in the State of Virginia in consideration of one hundred and fifty five dollars and ninety six cents paid by Byrd Sumner of Southampton County and State of Virginia the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged from granted sold and conveyed unto the said Byrd Sumner his heirs and assigns a certain interest in the personal estate of the late Henry Briggs dec'd of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia excepting only of such interest as the following Right his interest in the Murther of Cousin Pierce which she acquired by her husband the said Briggs and such money as shall have from the her of Negroes and rents of Lands which he the said Northampton has acquired in right of his wife when Northampton to the said Byrd Sumner his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And I do Covenant with the said Byrd Sumner his heirs and assigns that I and Lawfully seized on free of the afore granted property that they are free of all incumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Byrd Sumner and that I will warrant and defend the same property to the said Byrd his heirs and assigns forever against the Lawful claim of ^{any} persons of all persons provided nevertheless that if I the said Richard Northampton my heirs Executors or administrators shall will and truly pay to the said Byrd Sumner his heirs Executors administrators or assigns the full and full sum of one hundred and fifty five dollars and ninety six cents or before the 20th February 1822 with Lawful interest for the same until paid then this deed or also a certain Note bearing even date with these presents given by me to the said Sumner constituted to pay the same sum and interest at the time aforesaid shall be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in witness whereof the said Richard Northampton hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of October in the year of our Lord eight hundred and twenty one signed sealed and delivered in presence of Thomas Camp
