This Indenture made this 15th day of July one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between Samuel Dick ~~that~~ his wife Polly Dick Lewis Dick Sally his wife John Story and Ann his wife all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John Dick (abscon) of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Dick Tabitha his wife Polly Dick Lewis Dick and Sally his wife John Story and Ann his wife for and consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars to us in hand paid by the said John Dick (of Lord and his heirs and assigns forever all their interest in the claim or demand of in and to one certain tract or parcel of Land it being a part of the Land and plantation known as Wick thus further described and bounded by a late survey fifty three and one fourth acres be the same more or less and Bounded as follows beginning at a lightwood post a new corner of John Story in Polly Weeks line thence S 30° W 159 poles along John Story line to Dockery Boyants line thence along said Boyants line S 85° E 243 poles to a Turkey oak thence S 80° E 12 poles to a Spruce Gum thence S 50° E 107 poles to Lewis Dick line thence along said Dick line S 47° W 84 poles to the beginning to give with all right title claim claim or demand of in
