This Indenture made this nineteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one by between and amongst Jordan Pettman of Southampton County Virginia of the first part Richard Mumfer of the second and S. P. Parker of the third part Witnesses that It hears the said Jordan Pettman is indebted to the said Richard Mumfer as appears by a Note under seal executed by him the said Jordan Pettman to the said Richard Mumfer for the sum of two hundred and ninety one dollars and fifty cents which Note bears equal date with these presents and is made payable on or before the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty two and whereas the said Jordan Pettman in order to secure the debt aforesaid hath conveyed in Trust to Solomon Daughtry of Solifount County a certain tract of Land being in the said County of Solifount containing by estimation forty two and an half acres as is fully set forth in a deed duly executed under equal date with these presents. Now therefore in order more effectually to secure the debt aforesaid and especially for and in consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said S. P. Parker at an before the making and delivery of these presents to the said Jordan Pettman for himself his heirs Executors and administrators hath granted bargained sold aliened and Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell aliened and Confirmed unto the said S. P. Parker his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land containing by estimation one hundred acres being in the County of Southampton aforesaid on the east side of Potomac river & being the tract of Land which he the said Jordan Pettman purchased from the heirs named Richard Mumfer and which is duly and regularly conveyed to the said Jordan Pettman by deed executed by the said Richard Mumfer and Elizabeth his wife under equal date with these presents to have and to hold the said bargain and premises to him the said S. P. Parker his heirs and assigns forever upon the following Trust that is to say that if the said Jordan Pettman or his heirs Executors or administrators shall not on or before the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty two fully pay and discharge the aforesaid debt of two hundred and ninety one dollars and fifty cents and if on or before an application of the money arising from the Land
