This Indenture made this 5th day of November Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between William E. Evans and Maria a his wife of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one part and William Allen of Surry County and State of Virginia of the other part Testeth that the said William E. Evans and Maria a his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand and one hundred dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof the do hereby acknowledge that the said William E. Evans and Maria a his wife have granted bargained & sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said William Allen and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the said County of Southampton Containing by estimation four hundred and thirty four acres be the same more or less marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a hickory in said Allen's quarter Parcel line and corner to William Evans line three said Evans line 37 E 18 poles 336 E 14 poles 339 E 16 poles 352 E 10 poles 338 1/2 E 10 poles 353 1/2 E 14 poles 371 1/2 E 15 poles 377 3/4 E 12 poles 378 1/2 E 26 poles 374 1/2 E 6 1/2 poles to William's oak 345 1/2 E 16 poles 350 E 20 poles 346 1/2 E 13 3/4 poles to a corner red oak for Leonard Cobb thence by line 335 E 19 poles to 249 E 29 1/2 poles 322 E 27 1/2 poles 324 E 15 poles 328 1/2 E 20 poles to 21 E 18 poles by map for salt water oak poles 220 1/2 E 16 poles 218 E 14 poles to corner white oak 352 E 10 1/2 poles 349 E 18 poles 350 1/2 E 24 poles 349 E 22 1/2 poles to street front by Cobb's new ground 349 1/2 E 26 poles 357 E 18 poles to a corner Maple by Donald branch thence down the run of the stream as it meanders to Rottenway river up the various courses of said river to a cypress with three chops (not one) along another as a corner supposed to be the place where S. Allen's line comes to said river thence by line the no other chops then given near said cypress 329 E or 210 poles to corner
