 for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further sum
 of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Joseph Brite
 now here paid by the said Spencer R Jenkins at and before the
 sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged that the said Joseph hath given, granted, conveyed
 sold and confirmed and by these presents doth give, grant, convey
 sell and confirm to the said Spencer R Jenkins his heirs and ex-
 ecutors forever one negro girl by the name of Caspelle, about sixteen years
 old and her future increase and all the estate right title interest of the
 said Joseph Brite in and to the said negro girl Caspelle and his increase
 to have and to hold the said granted or intended to be granted negro girl
 Caspelle and her future increase to the said Spencer R Jenkins his
 heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever to the only person
 use and behoof of the said Spencer R Jenkins his heirs Executors &
 assigns forever and the said Joseph Brite for himself his heirs Executors
 and administrators doth hereby covenant promise and agree to and
 with the said Spencer R Jenkins his heirs Executors and administrators
 and assigns forever in manner and form following that is to say
 that the said Joseph Brite his heirs Executors and administrators that
 the aforesaid negro girl Caspelle and her future increase & unto the
 said Spencer R Jenkins his heirs Executors administrators and
 assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and lawfully warrant
 and defend by these presents upon Trust nevertheless that
 the said Spencer R Jenkins his heirs his shall permit the said
 Joseph Brite to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said
 Negro girl Caspelle hereby conveyed and have the profit to his own
 use without default but made in the payments of the said sum
 of three hundred and seven dollars and twenty five cents either
 in the whole or in part and then upon this further trust that he
 the said Spencer R Jenkins or his heirs Executors administrators or assigns
 shall and lawfully do soon after the happening of such default of
 payments as they or either of them may think proper or the said
 Spencer R Jenkins his heirs Executors administrators or assigns shall request
 sell the said Negro girl Caspelle and her increase if any to the
 highest bidder for ready money at publick Auction after having given
 the time and place of sale but their own discretion and given
 ten days notice thereof by advertising in the most publick
 place in the neighbourhood and out of the manse arising
 from such sale after deducting the charges thereof and other
