This Indenture made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1829 between Herrod Dols of the one part Henry Gentry of the second part and Jesse Bailey & Patrick Dols of the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said Jesse Bailey and Patrick Dols have agreed to become bail for the said Herrod Dols to answer for his appearances before the Judge of the Superior Court of Law for the County of Gloucester at the next term to answer in prosecutions in name of the commonwealth against him in the sum of five hundred dollars each in case of his default and the said Herrod Dols being desirous of saving himself and indemnifying them the said Bailey and Dols against any loss which may in any wise come or accrue to them by means of his said Herrod Dols default in consideration of the premises and of one dollar in hand to him by the said Herrod Dols Henry Gentry paid the said Herrod Dols hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell to him the said Henry Gentry the following property one negro man Collin one negro boy Peter one negro woman Junny and her child to him and his heirs forever upon this special trust and confidence nevertheless that he the said Henry Gentry will reconvey and convey the said property to said Herrod Dols or cause this deed to be released or the said property to said Herrod Dols or cause this deed to be released or cancelled in the event of its appearing to him that the said Herrod Dols shall have appeared in Court according to the terms of this recognizance the same being made appear to him by the said Jesse Bailey and the said Patrick Dols all which he the said Henry Gentry hereby covenants to do and the said Jesse Bailey and the said Patrick Dols agree on their part that they will notify the said Henry Gentry of their said discharge as soon as the same shall happen and the said Henry Gentry further covenants that the said Jesse Bailey and the said Patrick Dols shall make it appear that they have been damaged and put to loss by the default of said Herrod Dols in manner before spoken of that he will upon two days previous notice to the
