This Indenture made this 19th day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between Purdy Bradshaw of the County of Joamptown of the first part Samuel Pond of the same County of the second part and Patrick Rollings of the same County of the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said Purdy Bradshaw is justly indebted to the said Patrick Rollings in the sum of twenty dollars due by note bearing date the 20th day of March 1819 also six dollars and seventy five cents due by note bearing date the 12th day of April 1821 which said sum duly appears by reference being to the notes Also the sum of nine dollars and one cent as per note bearing date the 20th of Oct 1820 as per note bearing date the 25th day of August 1820 and also to have hereunto the said Patrick Rollings who stands bound for his security to Patrick Pond as of Colchester County which said debt with legal interest the said Purdy Bradshaw is owing and desirous to secure now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar to the said Purdy Bradshaw in hand paid by the said Patrick Pond at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is duly acknowledged the said Purdy Bradshaw hath granted bargained and sold released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said Samuel Pond his executors administrators the following property to wit one Bay Horse one feather bed and furniture twenty one heads of Hops one pot half dozen chairs one table also twenty five Barrels of Corn and two thousand weight of black fodder upon condition that the said Samuel Pond his executors administrators shall permit the said Purdy Bradshaw to remain in quiet possession of the said property herein conveyed until he shall in the payments of the said sum within or before or in part and then upon this further Trust that the said Samuel Pond his heirs and assigns shall and will as soon after the happening
