This Indenture made this 24 day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and
twenty one between William P Goodwyn of the County of Southampton of the first part and
William L Crittall of the same County of the second part Whereas the said William L
Crittall in order to secure the payment of three notes due from the said William L
Crittall and a certain Benjamin M Schuchin to a Jefferson Henderson the third
and of the Town of Portsmouth bearing date the 28 day of March 1829 the
first for the sum of five hundred and one dollars and seventy three cents
payable in twelve months from the date the second for the sum of five
hundred and eighty one dollars and five cents payable in two years from
the date and the third for the sum of fifteen hundred and eighty dollars and
thirty seven cents payable in three years from the date on the 20th day of
March in the year 1830 did by indenture of trust of that date among
other things convey to the said William P Goodwyn his heirs and assigns the
following tract of Land to wit a certain tract piece or parcel of Land situate
lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing six hundred
and seventy five acres in the same more or less it being the tract of Land which
the said William L Crittall purchased of a certain Arthur a Carr the due &
for which is of record in the office in the County Court of Southampton shires
and reference being had to that deed the situation boundaries and extent respectively
and at large appear upon trust for the purposes and uses in the said indenture
mentioned And whereas since the executing and delivery of the said deed in
Trust the said Jefferson Henderson has assigned the said above
mentioned debts to a certain Harry Williams of the County of Hampshire
and whereas a different arrangement hath taken place with the said
William L Crittall for the purpose of securing the said payment of the
debts aforesaid and the said Harry Williams is willing to release any
right which he may have in and to the said tract of Land Now this
Indenture Witnesseth that for the consideration aforesaid as well as for the
further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said William
L Crittall to the said William P Goodwyn at and before the executing
and delivery of this presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
by the said William P Goodwyn with the assent and approbation of the
said Harry Williams as witness aforesaid hath granted sold conveyed
released and confirmed and by this presents doth grant bargain sell convey
release and confirm unto the said William L Crittall all the estate right
title interest claim and demand both at Law and in equity which the
said Harry Williams and William P Goodwyn have or hold in the
Land described is have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land
to the said William L Crittall his heirs and assigns forever to the
