 his and their parts and behalf are or ought to be paid done and performed
 peaceably and quietly to have had a quiet possession and enjoy lease or rent out
 the said premises hereby released with the appurtenances during the said term
 of eight years hereby granted without any molestation or interruption whatsoever or by
 whom the said Henry Sep. Martha and Elizabeth Pills or either of them their heirs
 or assigns or of or by any other person or persons Lawfully or equitably claiming
 or to claim from or by them or under them or either of them his testimony
 whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this 17th day of November
