This Indenture made and executed this 20th day of November in the year
of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty one Between William L. Everett &
his wife of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia
of the one part and William Allen of the county of same and state
aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said William L.
Everett for and in consideration of the sum of twenty six hundred and
thirty two dollars current money of Virginia to him by the said William
Allen in hand paid the receipt whereof the said William Allen L.
Everett and wife do hereby acknowledge have granted bargain sold and
conveyed and by these presents do hereby grant bargain sell and
convey unto the said William Allen his heirs and assigns a certain
tract or parcel of Land containing six hundred and fifty eight acres
lie the same more or less lying and being in the county of Southampton
and state aforesaid and known by the name of Bars place and
bounded as follows to wit beginning at a pine on the side of the starting
ridge road in Thomas Stantley's estate line thence N 54th West 54 poles
S 77th W 34 poles N 5th W 16 poles S 83th W 22 poles S 75th W 22 poles N 54th W 11 poles
S 19th W 14 poles S 26th W 26 poles S 53th W 8 poles S 17th W 40 poles to a pine
near William Allen's line S 74th W 16 poles N 53th W 82 poles S 48th
W 12 poles S 11th W 73 poles to a dead pine cut down a corner of William
Allen's at his fence thence S 26th E 22 poles S 47th E 34 poles S 28th E 20 poles S 56th
poles S 77th E 114 poles to a red oak and post oak joined together corner
of William Allen's S 57th W 38 poles to the mill pond thence down the
various courses of the run of said Pond to said Everett's Mills thence then
down the run of the mill race on Bruns creek the various courses thereof
to a black gum a corner of Mathias Melian's and thence
Stantley's estate land standing near the side of the said creek thence
S 22th W 50 poles to a red oak on the line thence S 13th W 162 poles
to the first station to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of
