Allen in hand paid the receipt whereof the said William Allen &
Everett and wife do hereby acknowledge have of ranks bargained and
conveyed and by these presents do hereby grant bargain sell and
convey unto the said William Allen his heirs and assigns a certain
tract or parcel of Land containing six hundred and fifty eight acres
in the same more or less lying and being in the County of Gloucester
and State aforesaid and known by the name of Barns place and
bounded as follows to wit beginning at a pine on the side of the Long
ridge road in Thomas Stantley's estate line thence N 54° W 34° pole
